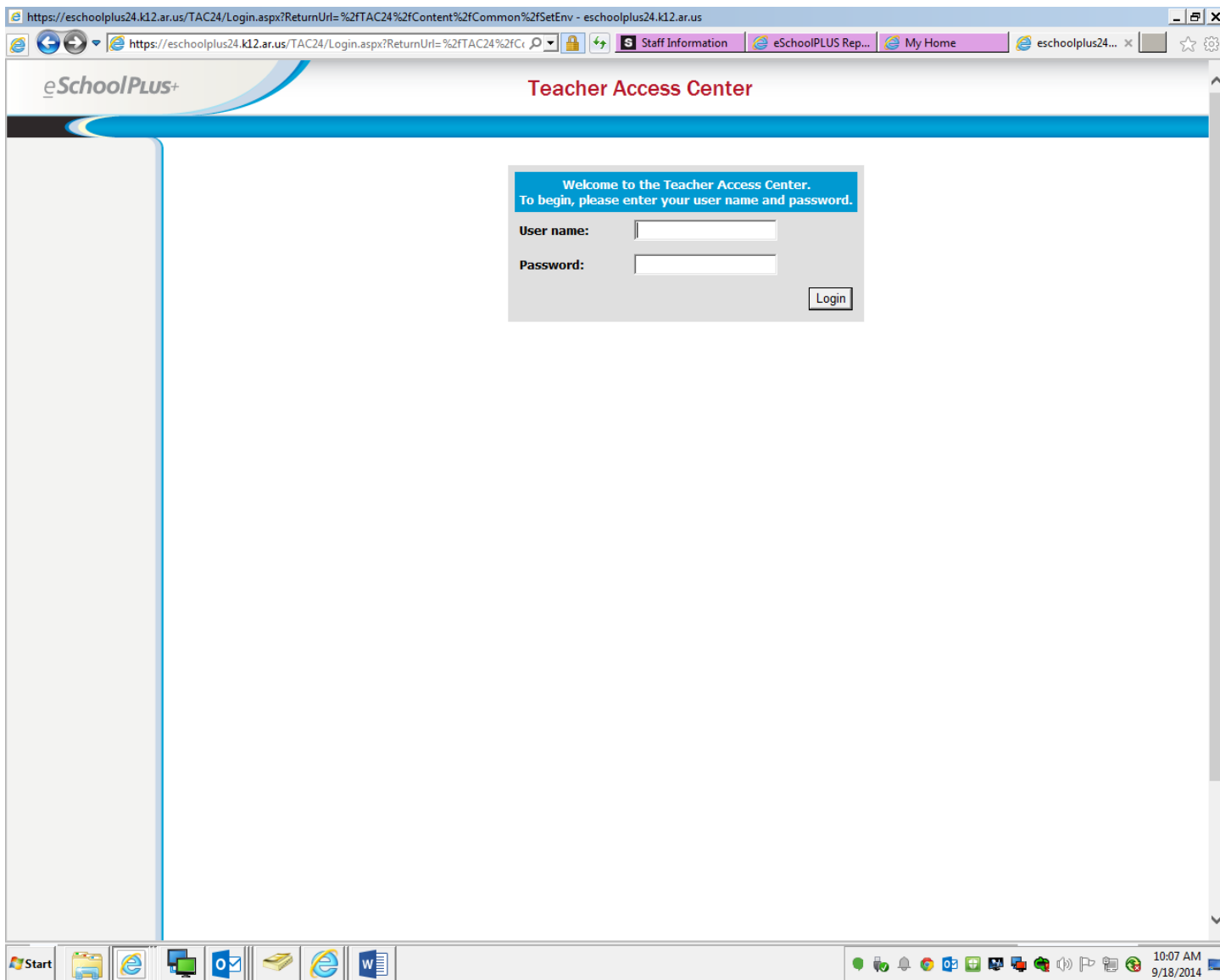


Compatibility Screen Shot Guide

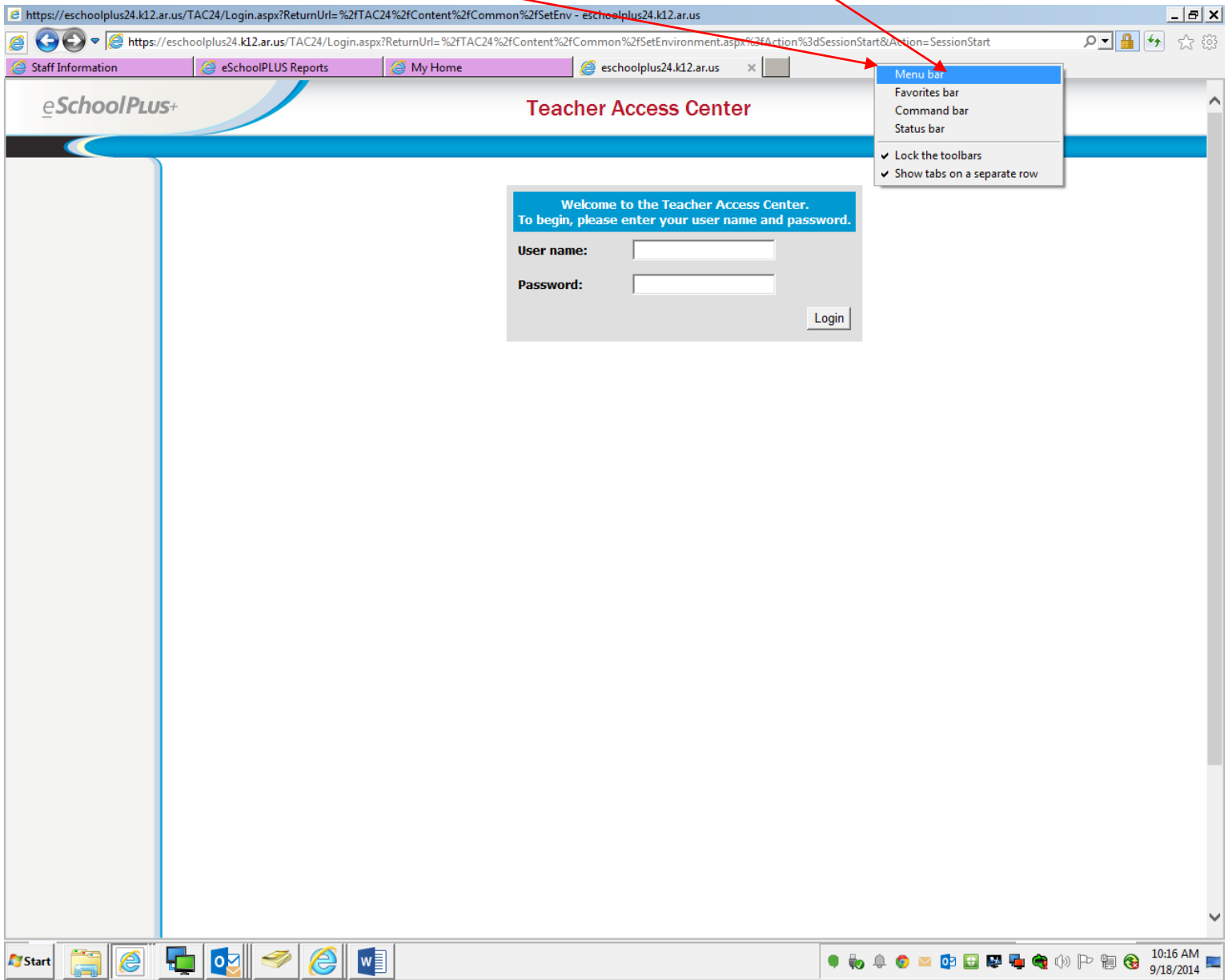
1) If you screen looks like this—with everything on one line then please go to #2:



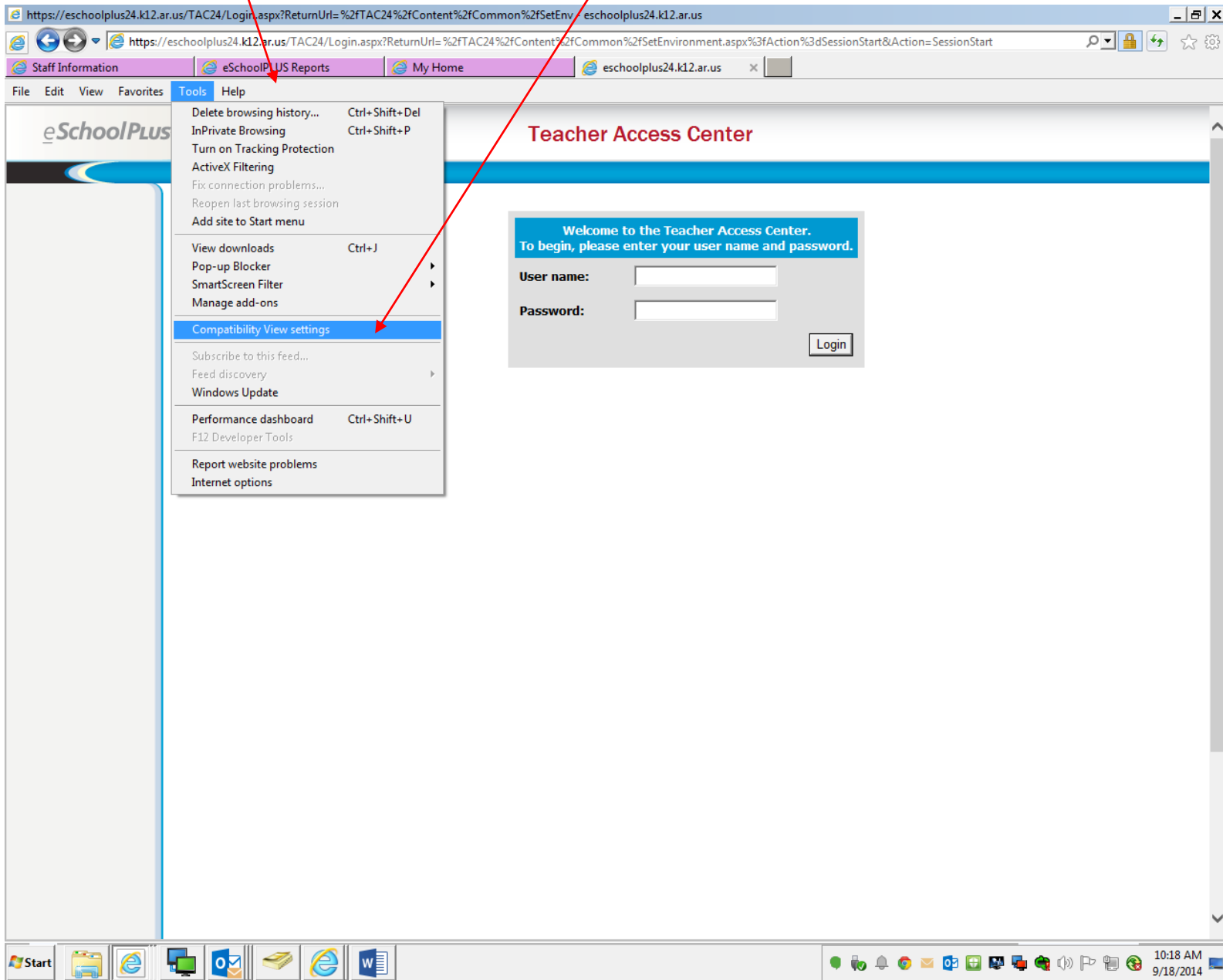
2) Right click on TAB and choose show TABS on Separate Row.
